Our initiatives include

- Provide professional development for staff around whole school evidence-based Pedagogical Approach of 'age-appropriate pedagogy';
- Increased community awareness of age-appropriate pedagogy practices within the school, and renewed involvement of community members in sharing expertise within the school, in alignment with these practices, to further engagement of our students;
- Mentoring and coaching of teaching staff around current implementation of age-appropriate pedagogies, including explicit embedment within Level 3 planning;
- Furthering a culture of coaching and feedback through scheduled Learning Walk and Talks within and across schools, and active involvement in 4 phases of moderation process;
- Sharing and showcasing expertise within school cluster, and school community, around age-appropriate pedagogical approach.
